Unpacking

- The porcelain products are delivered in protective packaging to prevent damage during transportatio
- Carefully remove the packaging materials to avoid scratches or breakage on the surface.

Usage Instructions

- Ensure that the porcelain products are thoroughly cleaned before first use.
- Do not use the porcelain products over an open flame, on direct heat sources, or in the oven.
- Regularly check the porcelain products for cracks or chipped areas. Do not continue to use damaged porcelain products, as broken pieces may pose a risk of injury.
- Follow the temperature recommendations provided by the manufacturer for use in the oven, microwave, or freezer.
- Avoid extreme temperature fluctuations to prevent cracking or breakage.
- Stack porcelain items carefully to avoid scratches and damage.

Heat Development with Hot Beverages

- Caution with hot beverages: Porcelain can become very hot when in contact with hot liquids.
- Pour hot beverages carefully to avoid burns.
- Use saucers or coasters if necessary to reduce heat transfer to table surfaces.
- Ensure special care is taken when children handle hot beverages in porcelain cups.

Safety Instructions

Breakage Hazard

- The porcelain products may break or crack if dropped or subjected to strong impacts. Do not continue using damaged porcelain products, as broken pieces may pose a risk of injury.
- Broken porcelain may have very sharp edges.
- Immediately and carefully remove shards with a dustpan and brush.
- Wear protective gloves when collecting shards to avoid cuts.
- Wrap larger shards in newspaper before disposing of them to prevent injury during trash disposal.

Child Safety

- Keep the product out of the reach of young children.
- The salt and pepper shakers, as well as the tiered trays, contain small parts. Please keep these small parts out of the reach of young children.

Care Instructions

Cleaning

- The porcelain products are dishwasher safe, including items with embellishments such as prints or decals.
- For lids with cork, and additional parts made of metal or plastic, we recommend hand washing with a mild detergent and a soft cloth or sponge to avoid color wear and surface damage.

Storage

- Store the porcelain products in a dry place to avoid cracking and surface damage due to extreme temperature fluctuations.

Product Labeling

- Refer to the manufacturer's mark on the bottom for information about the origin and quality of the porcelain.
- Check for any warning labels or special instructions on the packaging or the product itself.

Disposal

- Dispose of damaged porcelain items properly to minimize injury risks.
- Look for local options for recycling ceramics and porcelain.
